For the 2nd Annual Pallid Sturgeon 'Round-up'

- Extra volunteer help is needed to capture wild reproductive endangered pallid sturgeon for hatchery production and re-stocking efforts.
- We invite you to work hand in hand with Columbia's U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service fishery biologists on the Missouri River retrieving sampling gear loaded with Missouri River fish!
- We conduct an annual 'Pallid Broodstock Roundup' each year from **March 29 – May 7th**. You are invited to volunteer at any point during these dates, however coordinated intensive efforts will be from **March 29 (Tues)-April 2 (Sat); April 4(Tues)-April 9 (Sat) and May 3(Tues)-May 7 (Sat)**. We otherwise do not work weekends will be baiting and setting lines on Mondays.
- Our volunteers will be asked to help bait, pull and organize trotlines as well as untangle fish from gillnets.
- We have crews working around Jefferson City, Columbia and Boonville and will coordinate sampling locations with you for commuting convenience. Hours can vary depending on sampling proximity to the boat ramp, but will typically be from 8:30A-4:00P.
