As the volunteers happily finished their pizza, donated by **Sam & Louie's Pizza**, Jennifer Morrel from the **National Park Service** gave a great talk about the animals of the Missouri River, and showed some beautiful otter & beaver pelts.

Then it was time to show off our trash treasures from the day at the "Git that Garbage" Trash Contest! We were so happy to see the excitement in the kids eyes as they proudly showed off their animal finds from the morning, and other odd trash treasures. Check out the entire **trash tally!** (on the back side) All of the trash was then collected and piled on a barge provided by the **Army Corps of Engineers**, who were a huge help with the disposal process.

It takes a big leap of faith to get down & dirty on the Mighty MO and we can't thank Omaha and Council Bluffs sponsors, partners and volunteers enough for all the support they showed us while we were in town! **Thank You Omaha!!!**
