t. Joseph's history has always been intertwined with the Missouri River, beginning as a trading post for the American Fur Company and continuing as a one-stop shop for pioneers crossing the river heading west on the Oregon Trail and chasing after gold.

In recent years, a lot has been done to reconnect the city to the river that started it all. From the Remington Nature Center to the Riverfront Trail to the new public boat dock, there are more and more destinations for St. Joe folks that love to get to the river.

And that's what they did on October 16 for the first Missouri River Clean-up since 2004. 278 volunteers showed up that day. About 150 boarded boats from the beautiful new dock with more than 100 scouring the Riverfront Trail and nearby roads to clean up as much trash as possible.

From several groups of Boy Scouts to river rats with their own boats, from the Regional Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to college students from a handful of organizations, this was one excited and motivated group of volunteers.

The excitement was really visible as folks returned for a great lunch at Terrible's Casino, where trash treasures were gathered in piles to enter into our "Git that Garbage Trash Contest".

It takes many hands to make an impact like this. And the partnership of a whole lot of people who care.
